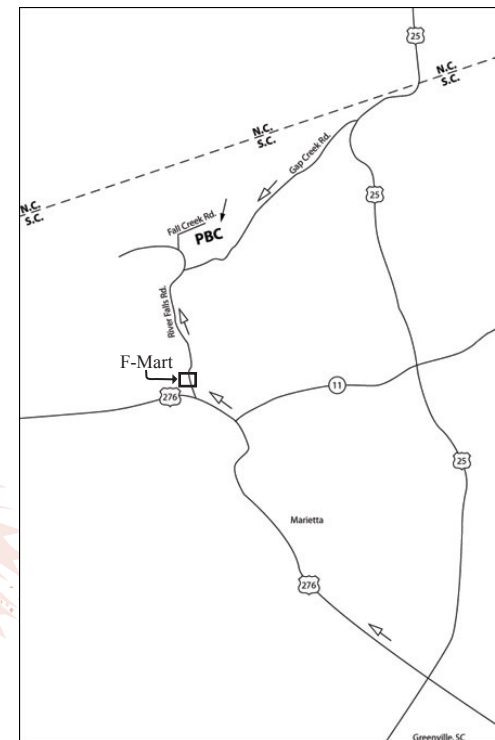

WHAT TO BRING

Bible, toiletries, towels, flashlight, pillow, sleeping bag or sheets and blanket.

We suggest a change of clothes for each day and a swimsuit. In case of cool or wet weather bring: rain gear, long pants and a sweatshirt or jacket. Shorts and skirts should be no shorter than 2 to 4 inches above the knee. *MARK ALL PERSONAL ITEMS FOR IDENTIFICATION.*

CAMP RULES

PBC is a Bible camp! All campers, staff and visitors must have modest dress and appearance at all times. Firearms, tobacco, drugs and alcohol are prohibited. Knives and laser pointers are prohibited except when needed by staff as tools. Fireworks are prohibited for campers but may be used by staff in organized displays. Skateboards are not allowed. Anyone exhibiting disruptive behavior in camp will be sent home. For the safety of our campers and staff, do not use extension cords for personal fans in the cabins. Campers may not bring cell phones unless approved by the director.

THESE RULES APPLY TO EVERYONE: CAMPERS, STAFF AND VISITORS! ANYONE WHO DOES NOT ABIDE BY THESE RULES WILL BE ASKED TO LEAVE BY THE DIRECTOR.

SCHOLARSHIPS
